- Scissors
- Glue

How?

You can use a standard white sheet of paper (A4), but any other type of rectangular sheet of paper will do. Once your zine is ready, you can decide to print several copies and share them.



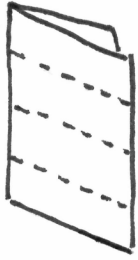

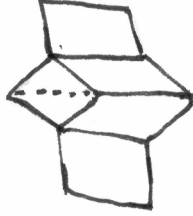
